Introduction

Farmers, blacksmiths, shoemakers, lawyers, physicians, and day laborers (collectively *tradesmen*) all performed work for others and expected to be paid for it, sometimes in cash and sometimes by barter. To keep track of their transactions, tradesmen, churches, government agencies, and corporate entities recorded their debits and credits in one or more *account books*. These books contain information useful to genealogists and historians:

Goods and services that were important to local residents.

Customer names, most of whom were local residents.

Church donations, pew rents, salaries, and the cost of operating the church.

Carpenters' books include coffins for customers. Such entries imply or confirm deaths (possibly unrecorded) in that customer's family.

Tradesmens' books might include family vital records and dowries.

Town expenses sometimes contain care of the poor.

Justice of the peace books and loose papers occasionally include unrecorded marriages.

Undertakers' books contain decedents' names.

ABOUT THIS BOOK

The purpose of this book is to provide a more complete inventory of account books than can be found using the online catalogs of the six historical societies. Many account books listed in card catalogs, paper finding aids, and online finding aids are not listed in the online catalogs. This inventory, and the methods in which the data are sorted, furnishes researchers with a more complete selection of sources enabling them to deliver a better-informed paper.

This book provides basic information for more than 14,100 account books, of which fewer than 4,000 appear in the online catalogs. If the catalog or finding aid provided sufficient detail to describe an item (as illustrated in the six chapters), I did not examine it. Any item appearing in brackets "[]" denotes information that was not present in the

Note: Onsite work for this inventory finished in February 2020. Sorting the data (as described above) revealed minor issues with a few of the entries. Restrictions during the current (2020–2022) pandemic prevented me from visiting some of the societies to resolve those issues. Therefore, there are a few blank spots in the tables below, a few items lacking detail, and some possible duplicate entries. For example, there are "Freight" and "Rent" entries without specifying the mode of freight transportation (rail, ship, etc.) or the type of rent (house, shop, etc.). There are fewer than one hundred of these minor issues.
